Key Scripture:

"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." Matthew 6:9-10

Big Idea:

"Honoring our Father God is more than praise; it's seen in our desires and the choices we make."

- **God's Holiness:** Isaiah 6:1-3; Exodus 3:5; Hebrew 12:28-29
- **Living in Honor:** Matthew 5:16; 1 Peter 2:9
- **Jesus in the Garden:** Matthew 26:39 –
"Not My will, but Yours be done."

Call to Action:

- Commit to one daily action that honors God's holiness and reflects His character. For example:
- Show kindness to someone who is difficult to love.
- Choose integrity in a tough situation.
- Spend intentional time in prayer, seeking God's will.

Closing Thought:
