Asking God for Help - You have to Speak Up

What questions do you have in your heart?

James 1:5 Hebrews 4:16

Check out Waypoint's "One More" Initiative:

Apply Challenge:

Place the "One More" card where you can see it as a reminder to pray for the One God put on your heart.
